




<p><b>BSBI-BERLIN SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND INNOVATION GMBH</b> is a private German Business School with its registered seat in Karl-Marx-Straße 97-99, 12043 Berlin, Germany (hereinafter referred to as "<b>BSB</b> and</p> <p><b>R.M.K. GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS (Autonomous Institutions)</b>, located at RSM Nagar, Kavaraipettai, Gummidipoondi Taluk, Thiruvallur District-601206, Tamil Nadu, India (hereinafter referred to as "<b>Partner University</b>"),</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- BSBI and Partner University shall hereinafter referred to collectively as "Parties" and individually as a "Party" -</li></ul> <p>agree on the importance and the usefulness of establishing cultural, scientific and education links, in order to assert and to consolidate the ties of friendship between the two Institutions in their countries.</p> <p>This Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter referred to as <b>MoU</b> for this cooperation, therefore, contributes to the joint pursuit of education, learning and research. This MoU does not bind either of the two parties legally or financially. Its aim is to promote relations that will mutually benefit each institution, this being the primary aim of academic collaboration.</p> <p><b>1. General purpose</b> The present MoU defines the beginning of cooperation between the two Parties in all fields or disciplines of common interests. It will be articulated in protocols and/or agreements that will follow which will establish educational and/or scientific cooperation programmes and define their expected results.</p> <p><b>2. Types of cooperation</b> The Parties indicate their willingness to cooperate in the promotion of both educational (options and research) activities. Under this MoU, the types of cooperation may include: (please remove activity which does not apply)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Joint educational programmes and didactic delivery;</li><li>- Joint research projects and common scientific initiatives, such as seminars, lectures etc.;</li><li>- Reciprocal exchange of academic and administrative staff;</li><li>- Exchange of students;</li><li>- Joint academic programmes (e.g. double degree programmes);</li></ul>

<p>Confidential Information only to those employees who need to know it for the performance of this Agreement and shall impose confidentiality obligations on such employees to the extent permitted by employment law, including for the period after their leaving.</p> <p><b>7. Equal Opportunities</b> The Parties shall not discriminate against any person based on national or ethnic origin, colour, religion, political opinions, age, gender, sexual orientation, marital or familiar status, disability.</p> <p><b>8. Term</b> This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect from the date on which it is signed and will be good for 2 (two) years. Nonetheless, the Parties may extend the period of this MoU by mutual consent, in writing, by their duly authorized representatives.</p> <p><b>9. Data protection</b> Each party is responsible to fulfil the applicable national data protection regulations in case of receiving sensible data of the other party. In case of any data transfer, an additional data protection agreement (DPA) will be necessary and agreed previously by separate contract.</p> <p><b>10. Miscellaneous</b> 10.1 Any part of this MOU may be modified by written consent of both parties. 10.2 Should a provision or several provisions of this Agreement be or become invalid or contain a gap, the validity of the other provisions shall not be affected thereby. In lieu of the invalid provision or to fill the unintentional gap a legally valid provision shall apply which corresponds as closely as possible to the intentions of the Parties according to the purpose of this Agreement. 10.3 This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Germany. 10.4 The signature of the signatory transmitted by email or other electronic means shall be deemed to be its original signature for the purposes of this MoU. The exchange of copies for this MoU and of the signature page thereto by email or other electronic means of transmission shall constitute effective execution and delivery of this MoU and may be used in lieu of the original MoU for all purposes.</p>
