### 1.REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MEETING

  - ✓ AI powered Learning Platform (RMK Nextgen) has been introduced which gives highly personalized learning experience to the students based on their strengths and weakness. Faculty can continuously track students' conceptual learning, Engineering Attributes, career alignment, and their holistic progress.
  - ✓ Calibration center established
  - ✓ Mentoring other institutions for NBA and NAAC accreditation;
  - ✓ Research Coordination activity initiated with regular department and college level reviewing, targets set and being monitored
