#### 4. CURRICULAR ASPECTS

- a. New Regulations and curriculum for the students admitted in the academic year 2022-23 Principal stated the salient features of 2022 Regulations as follows
  - ✓ Each semester, the curriculum shall normally have a blend of Theory courses, Theory courses with laboratory component, Laboratory courses with theory component, Laboratory courses, Employability Enhancement Courses, Mandatory Courses, Audit Courses (not exceeding 12).
  - ✓ Maximum of one online course per semester, with the approval of Head of the Institution, in lieu of Professional core / Professional elective /Open elective courses.
  - √ 75 working days (or) 525 periods of 50 minutes each.
  - ✓ Minimum one third of the class strength is required to choose a elective course.
  - ✓ The maximum number of credits that can be registered in a semester is 36.
  - ✓ The students shall undergo the seventh semester courses other than the Project Work Phase I, if any, in the fifth and sixth semesters, provided they do not have current arrears and have a CGPA of 7.50 and above at the end of Semester IV.
  - ✓ Change in scheme of assessment and weightage for continuous assessment and end semester examination.
  - ✓ In addition to already available grades, 'C' grade is introduced for marks between 50 to 55.
  - ✓ Minor Degree or Honours Degree will carry 18 to 20 credits in addition to the credits essential
    for obtaining the Under Graduate Degree in Major Discipline

Principal presented the first and second semester Curriculum of all the departments for the students admitted from the academic year 2022-23 onwards and discussed the below points.

- ✓ Software development Practices and programming in C++ were offered to the students in first semester itself.
- ✓ First year students have registered their laptops to avail the wifi connectivity. Those who are
  not able to buy laptop the management has decide to provide the same on loan basis.
- ✓ Product development lab is introduced in curriculum itself as one credit course using Idea lab.

#### b. Idea Lab status and activities planned for academic year 2022-23

Principal conveyed that about the various activities organized by Idea lab to school students as well as teachers during odd 2022-23.

The idea lab is incorporated in the curriculum as Product development lab for the students joined in 2022-23.

Principal conveyed that RMD and RMKCET has got the approval from AICTE for establishing Idea lab in self-financing mode. Our management is readily accepted to invest the money for the establishment.

#### c. Guest Lecture series (Online) - YouTube live streaming - 2 Programs/Month

It is proposed to conduct two guest lectures per month and telecast to it in our college YouTube channel. The resource persons will be across the globe from various institutions and industries. Each department is informed to organize one technical and one non-technical topic per month.

#### d. Short Term course - Alumni - 4 Programs/Year

Management has initiated to conduct short term courses for the passed out students. Courses offered as minor and Honours for 18 to 20 credits for U.G students will be conducted as short term course and certificates will be provided. Planned to conduct four programs per year. With the permission from Anna University and UGC certificate will be issued. Details of courses will be posted in college website. Alumni can register, participate and complete the courses successfully to earn the certificates.

#### 10. PRESENTATION BY OTHER MEMBERS

- Principal sir informed that Mr. J Venkatesh and Mr. Ratnakar Rao has sent mail stating their inability to attend the IQAC in person and they conveyed their wishes.
- Ms. Sathiyarekha / Alumni of IT department 2014 batch and industrialist expressed her happiness to know about the growth of college in all aspects. She added that the juniors are very fortunate enough to have these facilities. She also expressed her gratitude for the excellent support from faculty college and management. She emphasised on the need to improve the design thinking capability and problem solving skills of the students. She suggested to have a forum for the alumni and junior's interaction.

Keerthana of CSBS department was selected by Anna University to represent in inter

university competition at KOTA. For that the withdrawal from end semester exam is recommended. In weight lifting conducted by IIT Gymkana our students bagged two gold two silver and 1 bronze medals. He thanked the management and Principal for their full support and encouragement.
